Dear Shareholder:

By way of a brief update to our newsletter dated April 17, 2012 the board of NWG would like to provide you with the following information.

The company's Scientific Research and Experimental Development (SRED) claim has been approved in full for yearend July 31, 2010. NWG is still awaiting the notice of assessment outlining when payment will be made. These funds will allow us to meet past financial obligations while we continue to pursue advancements with the friction drive technology and as well, electrical storage.

The company has been working with a Canadian manufacture to price out the 100kW wind turbine based on the detailed drawings of the 65kW.

CWind has now structured the team to:

- Complete detailed, optimized design drawings of the 100kW wind turbine drive
- Optimize the nacelle cover for best aerodynamics
- Manufacture and warranty the drive
- Supply the blades
- Engineer the structural requirements of the tower
- Identify and secure sales

In consult with Mr. Reyad Fezzani, the former CEO of BP Renewables, CWind was validated on the assessment of the market for large industrial scale wind. While there is delay in the advancement of large scale wind farm development, CWind will concentrate efforts on establishing a product and generating revenue by means of the 100kW.

The board is confident in this direction and will provide periodic updates on our progress.
