Dear Shareholder,

Following up on to the previous posting with regards work with SNC Lavalin, NWG has been very pleased with the engineering work completed to date. The first phase of their activities included an analytical review and feasibility study on the energy storage cycle. This work has been completed and has warranted moving forward to phase two of the work, including the design, costing and bill of materials for the system in its entirety. It is projected to take approximately three months to complete these activities.

All the work NWG completed with the National Research Council has been invaluable. We are able to provide clear evidence that supports the efficiency and operation of a specialized turbine which is the heart of the energy storage cycle.

NWG has also been introduced to a group out of Vermont with expertise and computer software necessary to specify some of the components. SNC is working in collaboration with them over the coming weeks to determine the size of the equipment and integration of components.

On the business development side, the board of NWG has identified the best market for entry and is able to develop a business case with great benefit to the customer, including cost savings and increased power generation output.

Several meetings are lined up over the coming weeks, with potential partners. NWG will continue to work towards the best interest of our shareholders and will continue to keep you updated on developments.
